Lodge shall not make arrangements to pay persons for assisting in the details of any event.

This should all be on a voluntary basis from the membership. All bids for the following year must be in by the October State Convention, along with a floor plan of the room that is to be used for event. The State Chairman along with the State Tournament Committee Member will make the necessary investigations to see if the Lodges have the necessary requirements for the tournaments they are bidding on. Their recommendations will be forwarded to the Florida Moose Executive Board for their meeting in December.

The Executive Board will award the tournament on or before January 1st, of the year they are to be played, with the exception of Mixed Doubles Pool (Jack & Jill) which are awarded One year in advance.

Only members of Lodges or Chapters or Bermuda in good standing will be allowed to play in any state or regional tournament. All participants must show Valid Picture proof of age and a Valid Paid up Moose membership card of the lodge they represent.

Only Lodges in good standing with the Florida Bermuda Moose Association will be considered for a tournament. The Lodge must be in good standing with the Florida Bermuda Moose Association in order for it's members to be eligible for competition.
